Wêreldboekedag is vanjaar op 23 April vir die 30ste keer gevier, 'n spesiale geleentheid om liefde vir lees te deel en ander aan te moedig om die wêreld van boeke te ontdek. Dit was 'n dag om 'n boek te koop, een te leen of selfs aan iemand te skenk, en om die vreugde van stories te deel. Laerskoolleerders, soos Louize Gibson van Laerskool Stellaland, het die dag spesiaal gevier deur soos hul gunstelingkarakters aan te trek. Louize het die rol van Saartjie uit die geliefde kinderstoriesboeke vertolk. Die belangrikheid van lees kan in vandag se wêreld nie genoeg beklemtoon word nie. Net soos 'n sportster daagliks moet oefen om uit te blink, moet kinders elke dag lees om vaardige lesers te word. Lees moet 'n daaglikse gewoonte wees, want dit lê die grondslag vir alle leer en is noodsaaklik vir kinders se toekoms.

## Ingryping nodig om reservaat te laat voortleef

STELLALANDER-DELAREYVILLE: Die swak toestand van die Henk Joubert-natuurreservaat het die burgerregteorganisasie AfriForum nou genoop om die provinsiale en nasionale regerings te versoek om in te gryp aangesien dié natuurreservaat in staatsbesit is.

AfriForum het reeds op verskeie geleenthede aan die Tswaing Plaaslike Munisipaliteit geskryf oor kwessies rakende hierdie natuurreservaat en ook al self waarskuwingsborde opgerig om motoriste bewus te maak van wild langs die pad. Die Henk Joubert-natuurreservaat is net buite Delareyville geleë en is een van die natuurreservate wat die meeste deurloop onder swak staatsbestuur. Die natuurreservaat is nie behoorlik omhein nie, daar is onwettige jagaktiwiteite, en die infrastruktuur binne die reservaat is glad nie op standaard nie. Daar is gereeld wilde diere wat in die pad opeindig en ongelukke veroorsaak as gevolg van die gebrekkige omheining en dit maak dit nog moeiliker om die onwettige jagaktiwiteite te bestuur as daar geen toegangsbeheer is nie. Voorts is die organisasie ook bekommerd oor die feit dat die diere by tye nie kos het nie en dat swak infrastruktuur daartoe lei dat die diere ook nie vars water het om te drink nie. Gebrek aan terugvoer en optrede van die Tswaing-munisipaliteit se kant af het AfriForum nou gedwing om die direkteur-generaal van die Departement van Bosbou, Visserye en die Omgewing om hulp te nader sodat hierdie natuurreservaat nog vir toekomstige geslagte behoue kan bly. In sy skrywe versoek die organisasie onder meer:

- 'n Ondersoek na die onwettige jagaktiwiteite binne die reservaat en die toepassing van die toepaslike wette om onwettige jagpraktieke stop te sit.
- Die installering van 'n behoorlike heining om die reservaat sodat motoriste en wild veilig kan wees.
- Opknappingswerk aan infrastruktuur binne die reservaat veral by waterbakke wat lek en pompe wat buite werking is.
- Hulp om die Tswaing-munisipaliteit tot verantwoording te roep en 'n samewerkingsooreenkoms tussen AfriForum en die munisipaliteit implementeer.

Volgens AfriForum is dit van kritieke belang dat die departement ingryp om die langtermyn bewaring van die Henk Joubert-natuurreservaat asook die beskerming van die reservaat se biodiversiteit te verseker. "Die onvermoë van die munisipaliteit om op te tree teen misdadigers, wat onwettige jagpraktieke binne in 'n munisipale beheerde natuurreservaat uitoefen, is skokkend. As die munisipaliteit nie eers hul eie eiendom en bates kan beskerm nie, hoe moet daar verwag word dat 'n dorp se inwoners en gemeenskap hul vertroue in die munisipaliteit moet plaas om die dorp se belange te beskerm. Die Tswaing-munisipaliteit trek eenvoudig net hul skouers op en neem geen verantwoordelijkheid nie," sê Jp Nel, AfriForum se distrikskoördineerder vir Stellaland.

# Slagtery werknemer kry 10 jaar vir diefstal van R3 miljoen se beste

**STELLALANDER-VRYBURG:** Thinus Becker Theunissen (64) is op 22 April 2025, na nege aanklagte van diefstal, tot 10 jaar direkte tronkstraf gevonnisd in die Klerksdorp Gespesialiseerde Kommersiële Misdaad Hof.

Volgens berigte het die beskuldigde, wat 'n bekende werknemer by 'n slagtery was, tussen November 2018 en September 2019 beste van verskeie boere in die Klerksdorp, Potchefstroom, Hartebeesfontein en Ventersdorp-areas na die veilingshuis geneem om dit namens die boere te verkoop, maar die geld vir homself gehou.

Die boere het die slagtery genader toe hulle besef het dat hulle nie betalings vir die beste ontvang nie en dit is toe dat hulle agtergekome het dat die beskuldigde die slagtery misverteengeword het. Die boere het 'n totaal van R3 miljoen verloor. Die saak is by die Klerksdorp Hawks se Ernstige Kommersiële Misdaadondersoekspan aangemeld, wat aan die lig gebring het dat die beskuldigde onregmatig en op diegene bedoel die geld

gesteel het en daaruit bevoordeel het. Na 'n reeks hofverskynings het die beskuldigde skuld op nege aanklagte van diefstal gepleit en op 22 April 2025 is hy tot 10 jaar tronkstraf op sewe aanklagte en nog 10 jaar op twee aanklagte gevonnisd.

Die vonnisse sal gelyktydig loop, wat beteken dat die beskuldigde 10 jaar direkte tronkstraf sal uitdien.

Die waarnemende hoof van die Noordwes se Prioriteitsmisdaad-ondersoekdirekoraat, Brigadier Georgia Moos, en die direkteur van Openbare Vervolgings in Noordwes, Dr. Rachel Makhari, het die ondersoek- en vervolging-span geprys vir hul volgehoue pogings om veediefstal uit te roei en te verseker dat oortreders die volle mag van die wet voel.

# Life imprisonment for man convicted of raping an 82-year-old woman

**STELLALANDER-MADIBOGO:** The Atamelang Regional Court in North West has sentenced Tlotlano Simon Monnatshitlo (50) to life imprisonment for the 2012 rape of 82-year-old Kelatlegile Angelina Phaka.

The court also declared Monnatshitlo unfit to possess a firearm and added his name to the National Register for Sex Offenders. The incident occurred on 21 September 2012 near Madibogo village, when Monnatshitlo, accompanied by two other men, entered the victim's home and raped her. After fleeing the scene, the victim reported the crime to neighbors, who called the police. Monnatshitlo was later arrested following DNA evidence that linked him to the crime, although one co-accused died before trial, and the third was

never identified. During the trial, Monnatshitlo pleaded not guilty but was convicted based on the victim's hearsay statement (admitted as evidence after her death), DNA evidence, and witness testimonies. Despite the defense's arguments, the court sentenced him to life imprisonment, aligning with the state's recommendation. Dr. Rachel Makhari, the Director of Public Prosecutions in North West, praised the prosecution for ensuring justice was served, highlighting that this sentence acts as a deterrent against gender-based violence.

# Release of equitable share funds to benefit North West municipalities

**STELLALANDER-VRYBURG:** The African National Congress (ANC) Chief Whip in the North West Provincial Legislature (NWPL), Motlalepula Rosho, MPL, welcomed the release of the March 2025 equitable share tranche, amounting to over R689.6 million, to eleven municipalities across the province.

This comes after National Treasury initially withheld the funds due to municipalities owing over R205 million to key creditors, including the South African Revenue Service (SARS), the Government Employees Pension Fund, and the Auditor-General of South Africa. The delays were linked to persistent non-compliance with the Municipal Finance Management Act (MFMA), particularly regarding third-party payments. "The withholding of equitable shares for non-compliance with the MFMA due to non-payment of third-party obligations would have severely impacted service delivery in our communities. We therefore commend the swift intervention by the provincial government in addressing these challenges and securing the release of these critical funds," said Rosho. Rosho made these remarks in response to an oral question she posed, which was answered by MEC for Health, Madoda Sambatha, on behalf of Premier Lazarus Mokgosi. She praised the efforts of MECs Oageng Molapisi (Cooperative Governance, Human Settlements and Traditional Affairs) and Kenetswe

Mosenogi (Provincial Treasury) for their roles in facilitating and enforcing settlement agreements aimed at reducing municipal debts. The eleven municipalities that benefited include Ditsobotla, Kgetlengrivier, Ratlou, Tswaing, Naledi, Mamusa, Lekwa-Teemane, Kagisano-Molopo, Maquassi Hills, Ngaka Modiri Molema, and the Dr Ruth Segomotsi Mompati District Municipality. Rosho stressed the importance of implementing revenue enhancement strategies, backed by strong financial management and active support from both COGTA and Provincial Treasury.

"This approach will ensure that good governance and service delivery are not compromised and that municipalities consistently meet the expectations of our communities," she added. Furthermore, she emphasized that municipalities that honour their financial obligations are better positioned to attract investments and drive development. She also called on households, businesses, and government departments to play their part by paying their municipal accounts.

# Trok jaag deur motorhandelaar en verwoes miljoene se voertuie

**STELLALANDER-VRYBURG:** In die vroeë oggendure ongeveer 03:30 op Saterdag, 26 April, het 'n vragmotor chaos gesaai, toe dit met groot spoed by 'n tweedehande motorhandelaar, Blue Diamond Motors, in Markstraat, Vryburg ingejaag het.

Willie du Preez, eienaar van die besigheid, is omstreeks 04:00 deur 'n sekuriteitswag gekontak met die nuus van groot skade by sy onderneming. Willie en sy gesin het dadelik na die perseel gehaas, waar hulle 'n toneel van verwoesting aangetref het. Volgens ooggetuies het 'n Ford Ranger vanaf Markstraat in Frenchstraat probeer indraai toe die trok, wat vermoedelik teen hoë spoed in Markstraat in 'n westelike rigting van die brug se rigting gekom het, die Ranger getref en teen Blue Diamond se heining vasgestamp het.

Die bestuurder van die Ranger het glo op die toneel weggevlug. Die impak van die vragmotor wat die besigheid met baie voertuie getref het, was verwoestend. Minstens 10 voertuie is erg beskadig, waarvan dit heeltemal afgeskryf is. Een motor is so diep in die besigheid se kantore in gestamp, dat die gebou groot skade opgedoen het. Die waarde van die skade

aan voertuie alleen beloop miljoene rande. Daarbenewens is die besigheid se mure, omheining, afdakke, kantoortoerusting, elektrisiteit, sekuriteitskameras en Wi-Fi vernietig, wat besigheid baie bemoelik en 'n ernstige veiligheidsrisiko vir kliënte geskep het. Volgens du Preez sal dit minstens ses maande neem om moontlik finansiële te herstel. Hy bly egter hoopvol en is vasberade om sy besigheid voort te sit ondanks die terugslag. Gesprekke is reeds gevoer tussen du Preez en die eienaars van Idwala (die vragmotor maatskappy) oor moontlike oplossings om die skade aan te spreek.

Die SAPD ondersoek steeds die voorval. Intussen doen video's wat op sosiale media versprei word, die ronde, waarop die dramatiese tonele van verwoeste voertuie en 'n trok wat diep in die perseel vasgesteek is, gesien kan word. Genadiglik is daar geen beserings aangemeld nie.

# MRM hails jail term for ex-municipal manager - urges tougher action against corruption

**STELLALANDER-VRYBURG:** The Moral Regeneration Movement (MRM) in the North West has welcomed the sentencing of former Dr Kenneth Kaunda District Municipality Municipal Manager (MM), Advocate Abbey Dlavane, to an effective five-year jail term, describing it as a victory against fraud and corruption.

Pastor Lesiba Kgwele, convenor of the MRM North West Interim Committee, commended the Hawks' Serious and Commercial Crime Investigation Directorate and the National Prosecuting Authority (NPA) for the successful prosecution. He also called for asset forfeiture processes to follow in order to recoup the monies lost to the municipality. "This should serve as a deterrent and send an unequivocal message that officials entrusted with public resources will be held accountable for succumbing to greed and corruption, as their actions betray the trust of communities yearning for improved service delivery," remarked Pastor Kgwele. Dlavane (61) was sentenced on Friday, 25 April in the Klerksdorp Magistrates' Court after a series of court appearances found him guilty on one count of theft and one count of contravening Section 173 of the Municipal Finance Management Act (MFMA). He received a five-year direct imprisonment sentence for theft and a three-year sentence for the MFMA violation, which was wholly suspended for five years. The court found that during his tenure as MM, between January 2009 and March 2020, Dlavane instructed

a credit controller to issue a cheque of R550 000 to Kumekucha Investment for services not rendered. Investigations confirmed that Dlavane was the sole member of Kumekucha Investment. Pastor Kgwele emphasized that the rollout of the Local Government Ethical Leadership Initiative (LGELI) Code, adopted after extensive engagement between MRM, the South African Local Government Association (SALGA), the Ethics Institute, and the Special Investigating Unit (SIU), would contribute to strengthening the Local Government Anti-Corruption Strategy. He further stated that municipalities would only reposition themselves for effective service delivery and sound financial management by adopting zero tolerance for corruption, rooting out unscrupulous individuals, and promoting ethical leadership, good governance, and accountability. Pastor Kgwele expressed confidence that the recently signed Memorandum of Agreement (MoA) between MRM and SALGA, during SALGA's Annual Assembly in Limpopo, would strengthen partnerships between civil society and municipalities in intensifying the fight against corruption and building values-driven communities.

## Stellaland-buurtwagte staan saam teen misdaad tydens massapatrollie

**STELLALANDER-VRYBURG:** Die AfriForum-buurtwagte in Bloemhof, Christiana, Delareyville, Biesiesvlei, Vryburg en Wolmaransstad het op Donderdagaand, 11 April, 'n grootskaalse patrollie geloods in samewerking met die Suid-Afrikaanse Polisiediens (SAPD), plaaslike gemeenskapspolisieringsforums (GPF), gemeenskapslede, sekuriteitsmaatskappye en ander veiligheidsinstansies.

Die massapatrollie, wat omstreeks 18:00 begin en tot 04:00 die volgende oggend voortgeduur het, het ten doel gehad om polisieringsigbaarheid in die onderskeie gebiede te verhoog en sodoende misdaad te bekamp. Geen ernstige voorvalle is gedurende die patrollie aangemeld nie, 'n aanduiding dat verhoogde sigbaarheid 'n doeltreffende afskrikmiddel teen misdaad is. Altesaam 78 patroleerders het deelgeneem en 954 km is in 40 voertuie afgelê. Volgens Jp Nel, AfriForum se distrikskoördineerder vir Stellaland, is die sukses van hierdie massapatrollie 'n bewys van die krag van samewerking tussen gemeenskappe, wetstoepassers en burgerlike strukture. "Die Stellaland-buurtwagte

sal voortgaan om aktief betrokke te wees deur gereeld patrollies te hou en ander projekte aan te pak in samewerking met die SAPD en sekuriteitsrolspelers. Die verhoogde sigbaarheid speel 'n belangrike rol in die voorkoming van misdaad." Hy het verder beklemtoon dat opleiding en toewyding van AfriForum se buurtwagte duidelik sigbaar was tydens hierdie patrollie. "Ons wil ander dorpe aanmoedig om betrokke te raak by AfriForum se strukture, buurtwagte speel 'n kardinale rol in die veiligheid van gemeenskappe," het hy gesê. AfriForum Stellaland spreek sy opregte dank uit teenoor elke patroleerder en rolspeler wat hul tyd en energie gegee het om die patrollie 'n sukses te maak.

## Sekuriteitsbedryf staan saam teen voorgestelde vuurwapenregulasies

**STELLALANDER-VRYBURG:** Die vernaamste liggame in die private sekuriteitsbedryf het hul gesamentlike teenkanting uitgespreek teen die voorgestelde wysigings aan die Vuurwapenregulasies soos onlangs deur die Private Security Industry Regulatory Authority (PSIRA) gepubliseer.

Organisasies soos SANSEA, SASA, Nasionale Sekuriteitsforum, HUB van die Nasionale Kollektiewe Bedinging Koördineerder, TAPSOSA en LASA, wat werkgewers regoor die private sekuriteitssektor verteenwoordig, het hul ernstige kommer uitgespreek oor die wysigings wat deur die Minister van Polisie, Senzo Mchunu, voorgestel is. Hierdie wysigings het ten doel om beheer oor vuurwapens en wapens te versterk en regulatoriese toesig te verhoog. Volgens die bedryf is die voorgestelde veranderinge egter skadelik vir operasionele vermoëns en kan dit uiteindelik die veiligheid van die publiek ernstig in gevaar stel. Steve Conradie, nasionale voorsitter van die Nasionale Sekuriteitsforum en woordvoerder van die koalisie, het gesê: "Ons is ernstig bekommerd oor die moontlike negatiewe impak van hierdie regulasies op beide die stabiliteit van die bedryf en die

breër gemeenskap se veiligheid." Die organisasies het die regskenner, Martin Hood van MJ Hood and Associates, aangestel om die formele teenkanting namens die koalisie aan PSIRA voor te lê. "Ons doen 'n beroep op die regering om met die sektor saam te werk om oplossings te vind wat beide verantwoordbaarheid én operasionele volhoubaarheid ondersteun," het Conradie beklemtoon. Die organisasies moedig hul lede aan om steeds individuele besware in te dien, terwyl die werkgewersliggame toesien dat hul lede se belange deur regsprosesse beskerm word. "Indien hierdie regulasies in hul huidige vorm gepromulgeer word, sal dit lei tot massiewe werkverlies en die publiek se veiligheid in gevaar stel," het Conradie gewaarsku. Lede sal deurlopend op hoogte gehou word van enige ontwikkelings. Enige navrae of bekommernisse kan gerig word aan die administrateurs van die onderskeie organisasies.

## Police are deeply concerned about reported rape cases

**STELLALANDER-VRYBURG:** The South African Police Service (SAPS) in North West is deeply worried and concerned about the number of rape cases that are reported across the province mostly in townships, rural communities' villages and farms.

The Acting Provincial Commissioner of Police, Major General Asaneng is therefore calling upon all community leaders, social activists, faith based leaders, gender and rights groups from across the entire civil society, to join hands to address what is clearly a pandemic afflicting society. Despite the development and adoption of integrated Social Crime Prevention Strategies and plans such as the Gender Based Violence and Femicide Strategy, Community Policing Strategy, National Crime Prevention Strategy and most recently the Integrated Violence and Crime Prevention Strategy, women, girl children and the elderly continue to be victims of gratuitous violent crimes perpetrated disturbingly by young men and in some instances partners or suspects who are known to victims. It is unfortunate and worrisome that there is an almost accepted perception and misdiagnosis of what is surely a pandemic afflicting society which often result in the apportionment of blame. This misdiagnosis is apparent and accentuated during the quarterly releases of

crime statistics by the SAPS where emphasis is placed not on the diagnostic analysis of incidents but on raw data or numbers of recorded cases. When incidents show a decrease, the SAPS takes the praises and yet, when the incidents show an increase the blame is put squarely on the failure of policing and not on all of the above strategies which require a collaborative, integrated commitment and approach. Major General Asaneng said: "No amount of resources or Policing plan will address moral depravity and societal ills such as gender based violence, domestic violence and other social fabric crimes. Why is it acceptable for young people most of whom would either still be learners or even unemployed to frequent taverns and drink liquor? Why are the country's Correctional Centres full to the brim with mostly young men all convicted and serving lengthy sentences for violent contact crimes? Surely, the narrative and the focus have to change for South Africa to save itself from itself.

## Families at the heart of 2025-2026 programme of action by MRM

**STELLALANDER-VRYBURG:** The 2025-2026 programme of action, adopted at the conclusion of the Moral Regeneration Movement (MRM) North West's two-day Annual Strategic Planning Session on Thursday afternoon, has placed families at the centre of its objectives.

MRM Provincial Convenor Pastor Lesiba Kgwele emphasized that the review of key strategic objectives is aimed at intensifying efforts to combat domestic violence, neglect of family responsibilities, and promoting sound family and community values. Kgwele pointed out that the new programme seeks to address the pressing issues of gender-based violence, femicide, child neglect, and substance abuse that are undermining the fabric of families. "We are confident that the priorities we have adopted, along with an inclusive approach prioritizing collaboration with civil society organizations, churches, faith-based organizations, the North West House of Traditional and Khoisan leadership, North West University, and other stakeholders, will contribute to the successful roll-out of programmes that will strengthen the relevance and visibility of MRM in our communities," he remarked. As part of its focus on family values, the MRM will also launch a Parental Skills Programme aimed at young

adult parents to enhance their ability to care for children and strengthen family bonds. The emphasis on families was warmly welcomed by MEC for Social Development, Basetsana Dantjie, who spoke during the session. MEC Dantjie urged the movement to actively participate in educating communities about stereotypes against LGBTQIA+ individuals, describing such prejudices as an attack on the constitutional values of equality, human rights, and dignity. "We will soon launch the 'Go Lekane – It is enough' programme, which advocates for tolerance, respect for the dignity of all, and peaceful co-existence. This initiative will also provide opportunities for collaboration and partnership," she stated. Acknowledging that collaboration is key, Dantjie noted that by working together, communities, government, and organizations can help reduce the negative effects of drug abuse, improve the lives of individuals, and strengthen families across the province. Dantjie also highlighted that her department has registered eight private treatment centres in Bojanala and Dr Kenneth Kaunda to support compliance and has established coordinating structures to tackle substance abuse. Seventeen local drug action committees and a provincial substance abuse forum have been formed to ensure effective collaboration and intervention.



## Police condemn brutal killing of woman found in shallow grave

**STELLALANDER-TLAKGAMENG:** The Acting Provincial Commissioner of police in North West, Major General Patrick Asaneng, has strongly condemned the brutal murder of 43-year-old Motlalepule Kau, whose body was discovered in a shallow grave between Tlaskgameng and Kudungwane villages, near Ganyesa, outside Vryburg, on Thursday, 24 April 2025.

Kau had been reported missing at the Mahikeng police station on Wednesday, 23 April 2025, and her body was positively identified by a next of kin. The investigation, following forensic leads, led police to the location of the grave. The police have not yet determined the motive for the murder but are actively searching for a person of interest. This individual, who is believed to be posing as a traditional healer, had some of the victim's clothing items in his possession before disappearing from his residence. Major General Asaneng stated that authorities are "hot on his tracks" and hope to apprehend him soon. Police later confirmed that two male suspects, aged 33, were arrested on Saturday, 26 April 2025, at Tlaskgameng village. They are facing charges of kidnapping, rape, and murder, and will appear in the Ganyesa Magistrate's Court on Tuesday, 29 April 2025. Investigations are ongoing.

## New liquor trading hours take effect in North West

**STELLALANDER-VRYBURG:** For the first time, liquor stores in the North West were open over the recent long weekend, following the introduction of the new North West Liquor Licensing Amendment Act, which came into effect on April 1.

The new legislation replaces the Liquor Act 27 of 1989, which ceased to operate on March 31. Under the updated regulations, liquor stores may now operate from 09:00 to 17:00 on Sundays and public holidays, and from 08:00 to 20:00 on weekdays and Saturdays. Supermarkets that sell wine are permitted to trade from 08:00 to 17:00 from Monday to Saturday, and from 09:00 to 17:00 on Sundays and public holidays. However, trading hours for liquor at pubs, restaurants, clubs, and taverns have been reduced by two hours. These establishments may now only serve liquor between 10:00 and midnight. According to research conducted during the amendment process, most contact crimes were found to occur between midnight and 02:00, leading to the decision to limit late-night alcohol sales. Event licenses allow liquor trading from 10:00 to midnight for businesses, while residential event licenses permit trading from 10:00 to 22:00.
